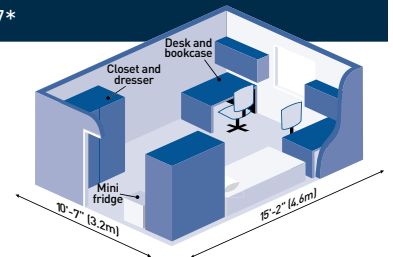

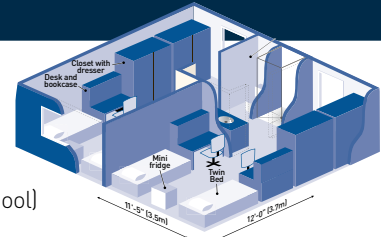

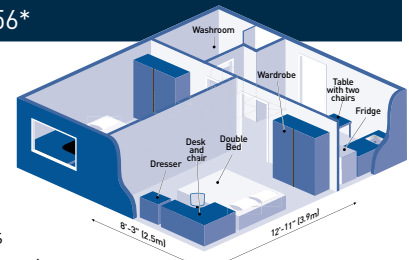

I love being around people constantly. When I walk out into the hallway I am greeted by so many people and

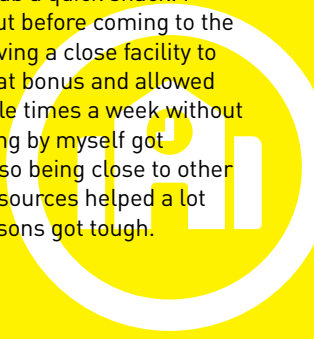
