Deliverables by Millionminds:

### 01. Accelerate: The Startup Talk

Millionminds invites successful startup entrepreneurs to engage with students' on-campus, in an hour-long interactive session, wherein the speaker shares their knowledge of the startup business & entrepreneurship, insights from the startup ecosystem, and their startup journey.

Purpose:

- To introduce the students to the startup ecosystem and various business concepts
- Allow students the opportunity to interact with people who started like them, from their city – people with whom the students can easily relate

Millionminds will be responsible for:

- Arranging Entrepreneur Speakers for the session
- Promotional Material for the Event, that includes:
  - Pre-event Posters
  - Pre-event Social Media Post
  - Event day Banner
- Arranging Videographer for the Session

College must ensure:

- Attendance of at least 100-150 students
- Online & offline event promotion through Creative's provided by Millionminds Team
- Provide basic seminar infrastructure facilities, that include:
  - A room with seating capacity of at least 100 individuals (as per audience count)
  - Adequate Lighting and Sound Facilities
  - Projector





## 02. Millionminds Webinars

Millionminds hosts sessions with industry doyens who have achieved great success. These sessions are broadcasted at all the campuses through webinar technology, and can be accessed by the colleges through the unique user id shared with them.

### Purpose:

- To help students understand the startup ecosystem and industry scenario
- Allow students the opportunity to interact with people towards whom they look up to for inspiration

### Millionminds will deliver:

- i. Arranging Speakers for the session
- ii. Promotional Material for the Event
- iii. Arranging Technical Facilities for the Session
- iv. Unique User Id and Password for the college authority to access the webinar session

### College must ensure:

- Online & offline event promotion through Creative's provided by Millionminds Team
- Technical requirements (will be communicated before the event)
- The session is viewed by the students of the institute

## 03. Axiom – Entrepreneurship Learning Program

Axiom is a two step, comprehensive Entrepreneurship Learning Program that engages students online and offline, ensuring that the students learn from the Practitioners themselves.

- a. Virtual Exposure (ONLINE): Learner gets access to 50+ hours of online video content, rich with startup business and entrepreneurship knowledge from successful startup founders and industry experts, capturing each step from ideation to execution in 220 topics, under 32 chapters, and 7 modules, encapsulated in 3 Levels.
- b. Experienceship (OFFLINE): For complete comprehension, knowledge garnered must be applied in practice. The learners are therefore engaged in startup work setups, for a period of 7 to 14 days, where they can better understand the working of a business by working with the teams at the startup, and spending at least one of the days with the startup founder as well.







The students completing the course will receive a Certificate of Course Completion from Millionminds, and in case of good performance, the students may also get job opportunities.

Purpose:

- Offer holistic learning to the students about entrepreneurship, by engaging them with the practitioners themselves

Millionminds will deliver:

The session will be conducted and mentored by the Campustar (Millionminds Campus Ambassador; details below)
